WE HAVE CONCLUDED THE FIRST PILOT YEAR OF THE EAST INTERLAKE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT SUPPORT INITIATIVE WHICH WAS A PARTNERSHIP WITH THE INTERLAKE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. IN TOTAL CFEI HAS FUNDED \$39,935 IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN THE CFEI REGION. BELOW IS A LISTING OF THE FUNDED PROJECTS AND THE AMOUNT OF CONTRIBUTION.

- ARCHIE GRAY AND HELEN MONTGOMERY PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – *Stonewall* - \$10,000 – **Project is a component of Stonewall's redevelopment of playground facilities within its two largest residential subdivisions.**

- BALMORAL RECREATION CENTRE – *Balmoral* - \$5906 - **Project will give the Balmoral Recreation Centre a much needed facelift and improve the facilities infrastructure and reduce its energy consumption**

- TEULON STAGE – *Teulon* – \$10,000 - **Project involves the construction of an outdoor wooden stage in Teulon's Green Acres Park.**

- ARBORG AQUATIC CENTRE – *Arborg* - \$10,000 - **The Arborg Aquatic Centre was born from a community survey in 2003 that identified a water facility to be great importance to the community. The centre will be located between two existing recreation properties in the Town and will share facilities with the other properties as well as heating and cooling technologies will be utilized to make the operation of the properties for efficient. Programming will be offered for all ages from 2-92 with zero grade entrance utilization, water slides, 4 lanes of swimming and several water slides.**

- RIVERTON BIFROST CDC – FIRST IMPRESSIONS COMMUNITY EXCHANGE PROJECT – *Riverton* - \$966 - **The organization embarked on community review in conjunction with MAFRI to have non community members visit and access Riverton / Bifrost's attractiveness, preparedness for investment, housing sector, as well as a number of other key community attributes**

- *Ochekwi-Sipi Economic Development Corporation*- FISHER RIVER RADIO STATION - FISHER RIVER - \$7200: **The Project will develop a radio station for Fisher River Cree Nation that will provide the needed information and entertainment services to the reserve and surrounding area. The project will involve community volunteers as well as the hiring of on-air staff who will oversee the programming as well mentoring the community volunteers who will evolve into on air involvement. In total it is expected**

that the radio station will hire 2 full time positions, up to 6 part-time positions and well over 50 volunteers will be actively involved by the 2nd full year of operation.
